COURSE CLOSINGS: The following days and times the golf course is closed for outings for the month of January - February:

Jan. 14th - closed until approximately 1:00PM for the **ILT Northern California Golf Tournament**

REMEMBER: Every Wednesday is Men's and Ladies League Days and we have a reverse shotgun at 9AM each day. If you play early, and play faster than 2 hours for 9 holes, you may catch up to these groups on the back nine.

TEE TIMES: The high season has begun. We are very busy so do not forget to make your tee



times. People making tee times have priority on the tee at that time. The new website tee time system should be ready to go by the 5th of January. If you experience any problems booking a tee time, please let us know. If you are trying to play before the first tee time of 7:30AM, you must be off the tee by 7:25AM. If you are sent out to another hole to start, after you play #18, you will have to check in with the starter to get assigned back on #1.

REMEMBER: Members get to make tee times 60 days in advance and just

showing up at the course will not guarantee you a place to play.

SPORTS CENTER: Remember to make your tennis reservations on line. If you have any problems, please contact the front desk for assistance. Again, this year during the peak season, the tennis courts #6 and #7 (at Residential) will also be available for members.



Being installed towards the later part of January, we will have a brand new pump system. This system will allow us to equalize our pressure and run the irrigation system in a more efficient manner which should take care of most of these brown areas. Be aware that we will still have a light top-dressing of sand every two or three weeks as our normal maintenance.
